	#1. Friday Night Blitz: March 6th. Four (4) double-rounds in 3 Sections (K-5, K-12, and College). Time control is Game-in-5, no time delay, with 2 games per round. See schedule and awards below. On-site Registration for Blitz opens at 5 PM and closes at 6 PM. Round 1 is at 6:30 PM. Open to any Scholastic or College Player, you do not need to be a Virginia resident to play Blitz. Players must bring a digital chess clock – no analog chess clocks allowed.								
Tournament	#2. The Main Event—2020 VA State Scholastic & College Chess Championships: Saturday and Sunday, March 7 th and 8 th .								
Format and	 One College Section: All 4 rounds played on Saturday. Time Control is Game-60, delay 10 for all rounds. Players must be enrolled full-time in a VA college or university, or be a Virginia Resident attending college out-of-state. Titled FM, GM or IM college players cannot be more than 25 years old as of September 1, 2019. 								
Player Eligibility	• <u>Eight (8) Scholastic Sections</u> : K-12 Championship and K-12 Under 1400; K-8 Championship and K-8 Under 1200; K-5 Championship and K-5 Under 1000; and, K-3 Championship and K-3 Under 600. Players can "play up" into a higher section. Time Control: Rds 1-2 (G/60; delay 10), Rds 3-5 (G/90; d10). Scholastic players must be attending a public, private or home school in VA, or be a VA Resident attending school out-of-state. Unrated players may play in any section according to their school grade.								
	#3. Parents and Friends (P&F) Tournament: For adults only (e.g. parents, coaches, family frie other adult players), no scholastic or college players. 4 rounds of USCF-rated chess, with Round Sat. and Rounds 3 and 4 on Sun. The winners of the K5, K-8 and K-12 Championship Sections are eligible to represent Virginia at prestigious National Chess events in late July 2019 as part of the U.S. Open in St. Louis, MO. The top girl in the K-12 Championship Section is eligible to represent VA at the National Girl's Tournament of Champions in late July during the U.S. Open in St. Louis, MO.

- 1. Please complete all information. ONE ENTRY FORM PER PLAYER, you can send multiple entries in the same envelope.
- Player Eligibility:
 - a. Blitz: Open to all scholastic and college students, REGARDLESS OF STATE OF RESIDENCY.
 - b. <u>Main Event</u>: Scholastic players must be attending a public, private or home school in VA; or, they can be Virginia Residents who are attending school out-of-state. College Section players must be enrolled full-time in a VA college or university, or be a Virginia Resident attending college elsewhere.
 - c. Parents & Friends: No scholastic or college players; Adults only.
- NOTE about the Sections: The Championship Sections are for players with any US Chess Rating. The "Under" Sections are for
 players whose US Chess Rating is BELOW the threshold for that section. Unrated players are allowed to play in the
 Championship or Under sections.
- 4. Early Entry Fees: Blitz (\$20 per player), Parents & Friends (\$25), Main Event (\$50). If you wait to pay or register on site the entry fees are \$10 to \$25 higher. Mail payments by CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY, payable to "VCF" or "Virginia Chess". To qualify for the Early Entry Fee Discount, your payment must be submitted online or post-marked by midnight Saturday February 29th.
- 5. All players must be current members of the U.S. Chess Federation (USCF) to play in the Blitz, Main Tournament, or Parents & Friends events. You can join USCF or update your membership at the tournament during On-Site Registration, but it is EASIER and PREFERABLE for you to join or update your membership online at www.uschess.org at least 1 week before the tournament. If you join online, please bring a copy of your new USCF Membership Card or Temporary Registration with you.
- 6. To enter BLITZ, we must have your payment by 6PM Friday March 6th.
- Payment on-site for all events can be made by Cash, Check or Credit Card. Parents & Friends Entry closes at 11 AM on Saturday morning.
- If you mail your entry, complete and mail this form and your payment to the address shown below. If you entered on-line, you
 do not need to send this form. Mail-in entries must be post-marked by Saturday February 29th.
